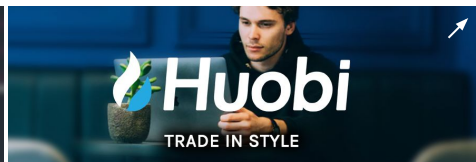
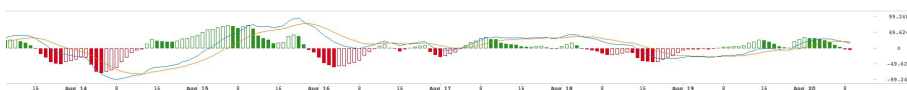


BLOCKMESA
