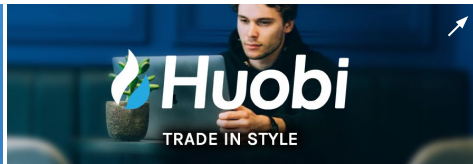

A volatile week for Bitcoin, price inching towards \$7000

This week has seen dramatic surges in the Bitcoin price both to the up- and down-side, but still trading within the \$6000 - \$7000 range. It's worth noting that with the latest slew of the Bitcoin ETF proposals getting rejected, its effect on the market has been mostly neutral.

Last year Vitalik stated that the supply of Eth would not far exceed 100m and block 5,5m not be mined until 2128. Eth currently stands at a 101,579,000 supply and block 6,193,000, a discrepancy currently valued at \$1.5 billion. [More on EIP-1234.](#)

BitMEX goes into maintenance, price jumps

BitMEX, popular for its massively leveraged margin trading, went into scheduled maintenance on the 22nd August. This saw an instantaneous \$300 price jump on BitFinex within a one-minute candle. The Bitcoin price has remained in the green since.
