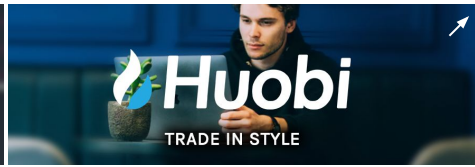


BLOCKMESA
